- A. Herod's reign
- B. Herod's character.
- C. Herod's plot to kill Jesus (2:16-18)



II. JESUS DISTURBS THE PEACE OF THOSE WHO TRUST AND OBEY HIM (Matt. 1:18-25; 2:13-15).

- A. A typical young couple with dreams and plans.
- B. Dreams and plans were distrupted.

III. JESUS DISTURBS THE PEACE OF HUMAN RELATIONSHIPS (Matt. 10:34-36).
