The Prophecy of Joel Chapter 2:1-27



I. THE PROCLAMATION OF DOOM (2:1-11).

- A. Blow the trumpet; sound the alarm (1-2).
 - 1. A shofar
 - 2. Sounded on the holy mountain (Moriah)
 - 3. Blown by the priests (cf. 15-16)
- B. Second description of the locust invasion.
- C. The greater destruction to come (Rev. 9:1-11).

II. THE PLEA FOR REPENTANCE (2:12-17).

- A. Analysis of true repentance (12-13).
 - 1. Sensible change of mind (12a)
